Avoid plagiarism by intentionally or unintentionally including words and ideas when they find their way into the writing. If ever in doubt, cite.

Other forms of academic dishonesty include, but are not limited to:

- Cheating: using unauthorized materials to interpret or answer questions on an assessment, or having another person complete work for you, or providing answers.
